Millard Refrigerated Services Joins IARW

IARW Members Now Operate More than 3.2 Billion Cubic Feet Worldwide

WASHINGTON, DC, August 21, 2008 – The International Association of Refrigerated Warehouses (IARW) and Millard Refrigerated Services (Millard) made the joint announcement today that Millard has joined the association's membership.

Millard Refrigerated Services is one of the largest refrigerated warehouse and distribution companies in the United States. Starting in 1962 with just 80,000 square feet, Millard has current and projected space of more than 9.5 million square feet, translating into over 275 million cubic feet of refrigerated warehouse and distribution space in 35 locations throughout the country. Founded by Larry Larsen, today the family-owned operation is managed by Chairman and CEO Lance Larsen and President Steve White.

IARW's 318 Member Companies operate a total of 995 PRWs in 63

different countries, including 676 in North America and 319 PRWs in other nations around the world.

Lance Larsen said “Millard is pleased to renew our relationship and work with the industry to build a strong environment for the success of refrigerated third-party logistics companies.”
